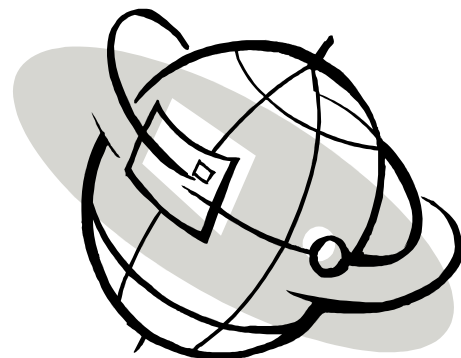

Research Degrees Conferred on the Faculty

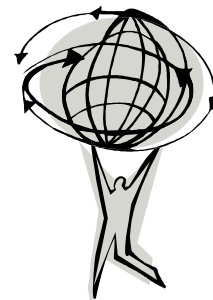
